

Nighttime lane restrictions on State Route 89 from Chino Valley to Paulden scheduled to begin Sunday, July 7

Motorists should plan ahead for long delays while roadway is reduced to one lane only

The Arizona Department of Transportation advises drivers to plan for lane restrictions on State Route 89 between Perkinsville Road (milepost 329) and Pittsburg Road (milepost 338), beginning Sunday, July 7, while a pavement-repair project is underway. Drivers could experience delays **up to 45 minutes** while SR 89 is reduced to one lane only.

Work is scheduled from 5 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Friday, July 7-12. Flaggers and a pilot car will direct motorists through the work zone. The speed limit will be reduced to 35 mph.

The restrictions are necessary so ADOT crews can do micro-seal work, which helps to protect and extend the life of the highway pavement.

Drivers should proceed through the work zone with caution, slow down and watch for construction personnel and equipment.
